**LOCATION:** Northwestern Pennsylvania at the SRCA home office site, 143 Forest Lane, Grove City, PA 16127. About 65 miles north of Pittsburgh, PA. There is a map on the conference web site at SlateRoofers.org.

**AIRPORTS:** Greater Pittsburgh is your best bet, but Youngstown, Cleveland and Akron (OH), Erie (PA) and Franklin (PA) are options. Allow an hour and a half to drive from the Pittsburgh airport to the site.

**CAMPING ON SITE:** 143 wooded acres are available with a lake for fishing, swimming and canoeing. No electric or hose hookups. Children must be supervised at the lake at all times.
